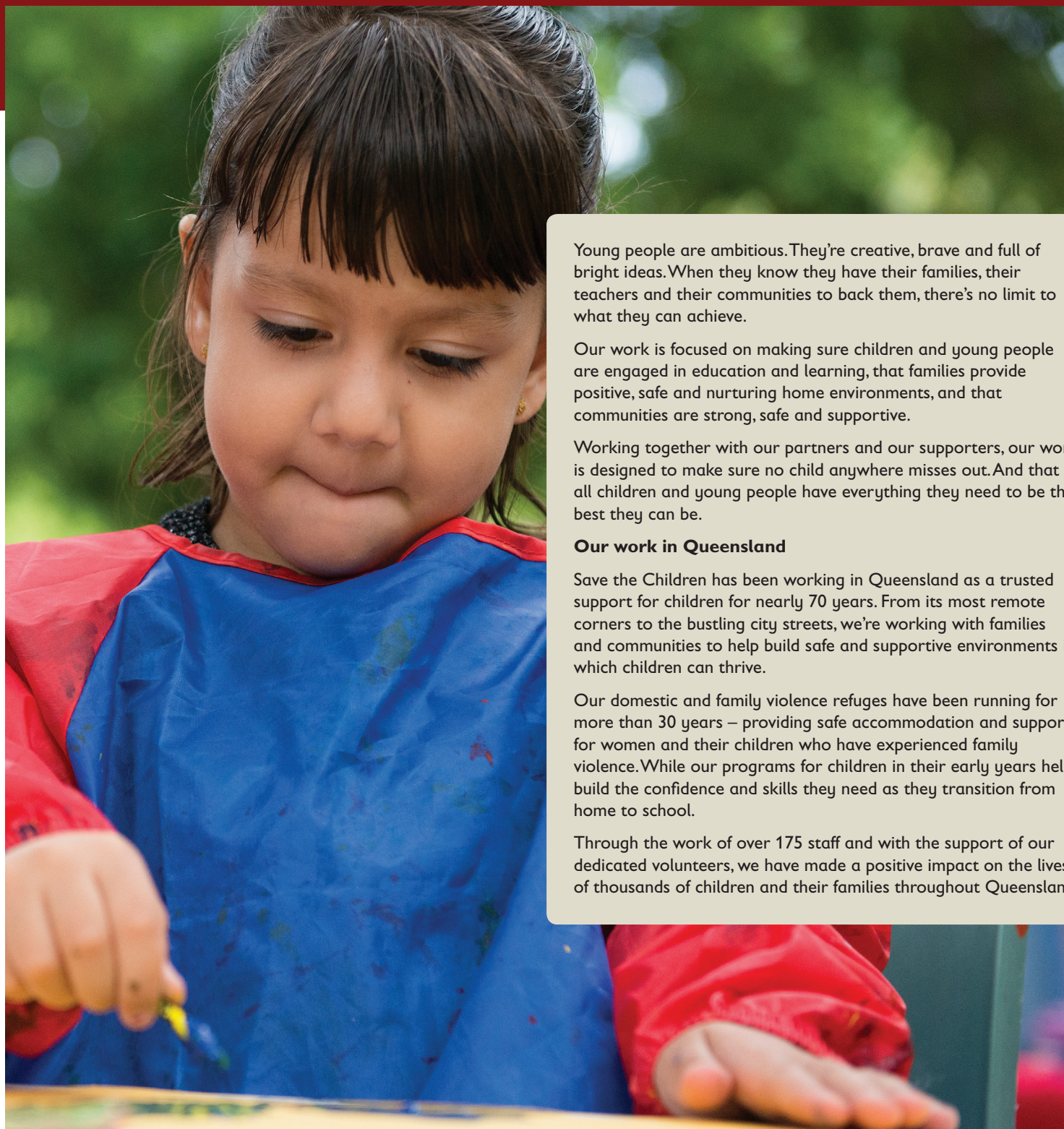

Our work is focused on making sure children and young people are engaged in education and learning, that families provide positive, safe and nurturing home environments, and that communities are strong, safe and supportive.

Working together with our partners and our supporters, our work is designed to make sure no child anywhere misses out. And that all children and young people have everything they need to be the best they can be.

Our work in Queensland

Save the Children has been working in Queensland as a trusted support for children for nearly 70 years. From its most remote corners to the bustling city streets, we're working with families and communities to help build safe and supportive environments in which children can thrive.

Our domestic and family violence refuges have been running for more than 30 years – providing safe accommodation and support for women and their children who have experienced family violence. While our programs for children in their early years help build the confidence and skills they need as they transition from home to school.

Through the work of over 175 staff and with the support of our dedicated volunteers, we have made a positive impact on the lives of thousands of children and their families throughout Queensland.

Our work in Queensland

Remote communities

We are working together with community through the Dumaji Children and Family Centre in the north-west corner of the state. The centre is a hub of integrated services for local Aboriginal children and their families, helping build strong foundations for learning and life. It provides access to child health services, early intervention to improve child health, playgroups and activities in preparation for school, and parent workshops to help promote positive learning environments in the home.



Leaders of tomorrow

We're particularly proud of the work we do alongside Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities – working together to help strengthen community spirit and promote connection to culture. Our Youth Development Program provides cultural education, leadership training and opportunities for personal development to help identify and nurture the leadership potential of young people in the community.



Mums, dads and carers

For some families, bringing a child into the world comes with unique challenges. We're doing what we can to make sure families with complex needs have the support they need to raise their child in a safe and supportive home environment. Our Secondary Family support program is a one-to-one, professional, homebased support to families which helps make sure all children are adequately supervised and have their physical, health, emotional, developmental and educational needs met.



Young children

The early years of a child's life are so important for their development. So throughout Brisbane and across the state we run kindergartens and playgroups to give young children the opportunity to grow and develop through safe and supported play. Our playgroups also provide parents with support, by connecting them with other services and building their strengths and confidence.
